

**BOROUGH OF SUSSEX  
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-05**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SUBSECTION 9-3.10, ENTITLED “PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES”, OF CHAPTER IX, ENTITLED “TRAFFIC”, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SUSSEX, COUNTY OF SUSSEX AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Sussex, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Subsection 9-3.10, entitled “Parking of Commercial Vehicles”, of Chapter IX, entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Sussex, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-3.10 Parking of Commercial Vehicles.

No person shall park or keep any commercial vehicle exceeding 12,000 pounds rated capacity on the street or in the open on any premises in any residential district with the exception of school buses. This subsection shall not apply to service vehicles making deliveries and/or pickups of 30 minutes or less in duration.

**Section 2.** Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3.** Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or contrariness.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately on its final passage and publication as required by law.
