SUSSEX BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 2022-13

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XXIV, SECTION 24 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SUSSEX ESTABLISHING FEES

BE IT NOW ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Sussex that the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Sussex are hereby amended as follows:

Section 1.

Subparagraph (j) of Section 24-1.4 of the Code of the Borough of Sussex shall be replaced as follows:

§24-1.4 Water/Sewer System Fees

- j) Quarterly charges for use of water and sewer:
 - 1. Water Fees:

The per gallon fee is \$0.0123 per gallon and \$173.28 minimum per EDU (equivalent dwelling unit).

2. Sewer Fees:

The per gallon fee is \$0.0110 per gallon and \$154.94 minimum per EDU.

Transmission fees shall be as follows:

The per gallon fee is \$0.0195 per gallon.

Section 2. Inconsistent ordinance provisions.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

Section 3. Partial invalidity.

If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective date.

This ordinance shall become effective October 1, 2022
