

ORDINANCE #2023-13

**ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF
NEWTON AVENUE IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF
SUSSEX, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY,
AND APPROPRIATING \$160,000 THEREFOR FROM
VARIOUS FUNDS OF THE BOROUGH.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH
OF SUSSEX, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this ordinance is hereby authorized as a general improvement to be made or acquired by the Borough of Sussex, New Jersey. For the said improvement or purpose stated in said Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$160,000, to the extent of \$139,730, from the proceeds of a grant received or to be received by the Borough from the New Jersey Department of Transportation and to the extent of \$20,270, from moneys available in the General Capital Fund – Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough.

Section 2. The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the appropriation is made as provided in Section 1 of this ordinance is the improvement of Newton Avenue in and by the Borough, including the construction or reconstruction of curbs and sidewalks thereof, together with all milling, equipment, site work, work and materials necessary therefore or incidental thereto, and all as shown on and in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor on file or to be filed in the office of the Borough Clerk and hereby approved.

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the

Director, Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Borough Clerk and are available for public inspection.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after publication after final adoption, as provided by law.
