ORDINANCE NO. 2023-18**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 24-1.1, ENTITLED “MUNICIPAL CLERK”, OF CHAPTER 24, ENTITLED “FEES”, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SUSSEX, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sussex, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 24 of the Code of the Borough of Sussex, entitled “Fees”, be and is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 24-1.1 entitled “Municipal Clerk.” of Chapter 24 entitled “Fees” of the Code of the Borough of Sussex, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, is amended to revise paragraph (b) to include the following:

Temporary retail food license – per event: \$25

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or contrariness.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey following the required 20-day period after adoption, as set forth in N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b).
